
Arf Arf!!! Welcome to YEG-PAH

In October, we chased some tails around the Edmonton Corn Maze. It was a day filled with 'corny' puns but was a blast none the less and everyone had a great time.




Handle every situation like a dog: If you can't eat it or play with it, then just pee on it and walk away.






Other Kink Groups
