Reminder that memberships for YEG-PAH are yearly renewals. See the website for details on how to renew your memberships and message a board member if you have any questions.

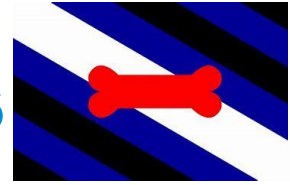
## Code of Conduct

If there are any ideas you have for future events, feel free to contact the board to let them know.

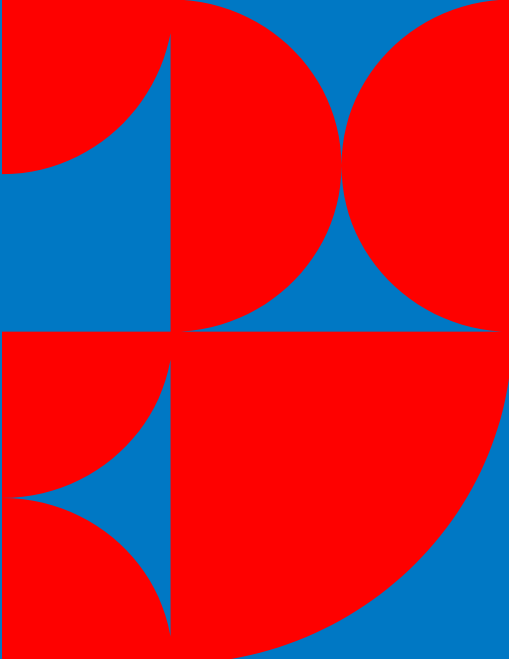
