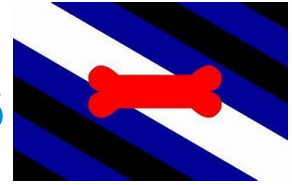

Pet Crash at the Foam Party? I think we need to go dancing and get sudsy so lets head to the foam party at Evolution Wonderlounge.



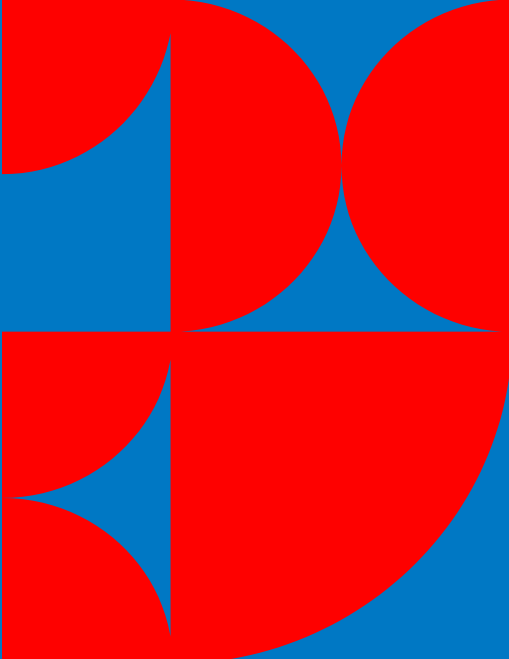
Upcoming Events

4	Kink friendly. All gear is welcome. No frontal nudity or insertable toys.
4+	Kink friendly. All gear welcome. Sex permissive. Clothing optional.
